Dear Mr. Duke:

This letter documents the Coast Guard's acceptance of 1-Call Alaska's Alternative Planning Criteria (APC) revision submitted per Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), § 155.5067. Therefore, the 1-Call Alaska APC is now approved for nontank vessels carrying OPA-90 regulated oils as fuel for main propulsion or as a secondary cargo operating within the Western Alaska COTP Zone for the following subareas: Aleutian Islands, Bristol Bay, and Kodiak Island. The subareas for the purpose of this APC are defined in the Alaska Federal and State Preparedness Plan for Response to Oil and Hazardous Substance Discharges and Releases – Change 3.

The 1-Call Alaska APC (Revision 2.1 – Provided to the Coast Guard on September 1, 2016), along with a copy of this letter, must be kept with and incorporated into applicable vessel response plans. This APC approval shall remain valid until **December 31, 2017**. This letter supersedes our December 28, 2015 correspondence.

Amendments to your APC may be required as a condition of future approvals. Any deviation from the provisions of 1-Call Alaska's APC must be communicated in writing to the applicable Captain of the Port.
